
When we pray the Rosary, we go to the school of Mary, and she teaches us how to love Jesus!

"It makes me feel happy and special."


"It helps me focus a bit more when I pray. I can focus and I am not thinking about all the other things I was."

We have an ongoing religion journal in our class and many students have written about how much they love saying the Rosary as a class.
